Food Baskets

- Christmas Food Assistance — Salvation Army
 - Call 303-295-3366 to find which office you should go to; families must register for assistance between November 5th and 10th to receive assistance
 - Families must have children 14 or younger to qualify and will need to show photo ID, current proof of address, and birth certificates for all children to register
- Christmas Baskets — Volunteers of America, 2877 Lawrence Street
 - Sign-up for vouchers begins December 10th at 9am and will last until registration is closed; must bring photo ID and proof of address to register
 - Basket pick-up will occur on December 17th and will require photo ID and voucher
- Christmas Food Baskets — Servicios de la Raza, 3131 West 14th Street
 - December 18th starting at 9am; first come, first served
 - Interested individuals will need to provide photo ID and current proof of address

Gifts

- Annual Toy Shop — National Western Complex, 4655 Humboldt Street
 - December 1st from 9am-5pm; first come, first served
 - Parents must bring a photo ID and birth certificates for children 18 and under
 - Parents encouraged to leave children at home due to anticipated wait times
- Christmas Toy Distribution — Denver Inner City Parish, 1212 Mariposa Street
 - December 14th, distribution begins at 8:30am
 - Parents must bring a photo ID and verification for each child 18 and under; this can include: birth certificates, Medicaid cards, shot or school records
- Christmas Gifts — Volunteers of America, 2877 Lawrence Street
 - December 18th from 12-3pm; available while supplies last
 - Have children's age and gender ready for assistance; must be 18 and under

- Christmas Dinner — CO Convention Center, 700 14th Street
 - December 24th from 11:30am-1pm
